



# Limitless: God Can Do More

## Connect Group Discussion Guide

When you serve a limitless God in your life there are limitless possibilities for you as you limit him less. Faith in following God even when it seems counter intuitive can unlock huge possibilities in your life.

- Circle Time: Share about a time you broke the rules and the outcome? Was the outcome positive or negative?
  - When is it appropriate to follow boundaries in our lives and when is it appropriate to move around boundaries in our lives?
- List some of the boundaries that God has created for us in scripture: *i.e. 10 commandments, prayer, etc*
- List some areas that God removes boundaries in appropriate places: *i.e. Beatitudes, Fruit of the Spirit*
- How does a parent know when to limit and when to set free in the development of their child? How is this like or unlike our relationship with God?
- Read Ephesians 3:20. How would you live if you really believed God could remove your limits?
  - Paul believed that it was impossible to ask God for too much. How does this influence your understanding of what we should bring to God in prayer?
  - *Paul is speaking to a mentality that has placed limits on God. Therefore they have limited themselves. They have stifled God's work in and through them.*
- Read John 6:5-13.
  - Who in this passage operates in Jesus' limitless power and who does not? What was different about the boys' approach than the disciples?
  - By whose hands were the loaves and fish delivered? *When we operate in limitless faith God can do limitless things through our very own hands!*
- What stops us short from living like this?
- Read Ephesians 3:14-21.
  - Now that you read this scripture in context, what are some of the themes you pull out from Paul's prayer? *This all happens in community*
  - What are some tangible steps you can take to elevate your faith into the "limitless" level? *It's not about self... It's about others.*
