Connect Group Discussion Guide

- Here is a common phrase, “God loves you”. Take a moment to really think about this phrase and answer these two questions:
 - What does this phrase mean to you?
 - Do you believe this phrase—why or why not?
- Read the 2 Corinthians verse. When Paul says “godly jealousy” he is saying two things: God is jealous and God’s jealousy for you is good.
 - “God is jealous” means, having no other god before Him (read the Exodus verse). What does it mean to have a god before Him?
 - “God’s jealousy for you is good” means that He has sacrificed much so you can know Him (read the 1 Corinthians 6 verses). What do these verses say to us?
- There is godly jealousy and worldly jealousy. Ungodly jealousy is controlling and all consuming, while godly jealousy manifests itself in His love for you. Read the Psalm 86 verses. How is God described in these verses?
- Endless love can’t be hidden; it is visible and obvious to all. It doesn’t end with receiving, it flows outward to others. How do you show love to others?
- This love should also be represented in our marriages. Scripture often uses the marriage covenant as an analogy of Christ’s love for us, but He also uses Christ’s love for us as an example of how we should behave in our marriages. Read the Ephesians verses. What do they mean in your opinion?
- Endless love is unifying. Read the Proverb verse. We should run to Jesus when we need shelter. Do you think Christians tend to run toward Jesus or away from Him? Why?
- Endless love may seem foolish to the world (read the 1 Corinthians verse) , but it is enduring. What are some statements of gratitude you can make about God’s love?

Main Idea

Endless love can’t be hidden; it is visible and obvious to all.
