

## **Connect Group Discussion Guide**

- Definition of history: It is the study of change over time that impacts all parts of human society: social, economic, science, government, intellect, etc. There has not been an event in history that has created more change than the resurrection! How has the resurrection changed your personal history? Think about this and be specific in your answer.
- 2. The resurrection of Christ is a "BIG DEAL!" It is the greatest transformational event in history. How has the fact that Christ has risen transformed your life? Share two ways.
- 3. You can google the most influential, significant, famous, popular person in the history of the world and do you know who #1 is every time? Jesus! What are two reasons you think Jesus is #1 in these search results? Fun Fact: The March 2019 Time Magazine issue described Jesus as 'the most persistent symbol of purity, selflessness and love in the history of humanity'.
- 4. Jesus was present in history and He is present today. How can this be? Share your perspective.
- 5. Read the John verse. Restate it in your own words and then share what this verse means to you.
- 6. Read the Colossians verses. What are these verses saying about Jesus—His role in creation, the world and in our lives as believers?
- 7. History is His-story because Jesus is weaved throughout the annals of time. He was there in creation, He was there in redemption of the world and He was there in the salvation of humanity. Though many have tried to wipe Jesus out from history, He cannot be destroyed or removed from the work He as done. A main reason is that He has engrafted Himself on our hearts when we believe in Him.
