



Connect Group Discussion Guide

Series: Elements

“Who is Jesus?”

Week of June 12, 2022

1. Christ isn't Jesus last name, it is the word for Messiah. Messiah means, “Anointed One”. There are three roles of anointing in the Jewish history: Prophet, Priest, and King. Take a moment to think about what comes to mind when you hear these three words in relation to Jesus.
2. Jesus as the Prophet of Prophets: Prophet is one who speaks for God. Famous introductory words are, “This saith the Lord...”. But Jesus didn't say, “This saith the Lord...”, He said, “I say unto you.” Jesus didn't speak for God, but Jesus spoke as God! What are some things that Jesus says to you in your day-to-day life?
3. Jesus as the Highest of Priests: The one mediator between God and man. Jesus is here for us to be the way to God. God expects that what we do, we do not do on our own, but we do through Jesus. We face our loneliness, hurt, rejection through Him! He is our real help in times of trial. He is our permanent and forever mediator! How does knowing this make you feel about your relationship with Him?
4. Jesus as the King of Kings: He is above all that ever existed. How does that work for us in the here and now?
5. Questions for additional discussion:
 - Who do you say Jesus is?
 - What do you want Jesus to do for you? (What part do you play in that)?
 - How often do you speak to Jesus?

NOTE: Connect Group Leader, listen actively and carefully to what is being said during the times when group members participants share. Let their responses guide how you tailor your interactions and studies with the group during the session. You are God's hands, feet, and voice during this time. Allow Him to use you as you participate in His activity in the lives of those in your group.
