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### The Big God Story

- 1. Talk with your little one's about what denial means. Peter denies knowing Jesus. Peter said, "I didn't know Jesus," even though he did! Peter says this 3 times, and after he says this, he is reminded of Jesus predicting this and Peter went away sad.
- 2. Find a comfy spot to watch the story of Peter we watched last week: Peter
- 3. Say: "Peter denied knowing Jesus, Peter said he was not Jesus' friend. But Jesus wanted Peter to know that He would be his friend forever, no matter what. Jesus forgives Peter, and Jesus forgives us too! Because Jesus wants to be our friend forever, too!
- 4. Do this Repeat-After-Me together:
  Who can believe in Jesus?
  I can believe in Jesus!

Let's end by praying together! Use this prayer to help guide you:

Dear God,

Thank You for Jesus. Thank You that He loves us, no matter us. I pray we will have the courage like Peter, to tell everyone, everywhere that Jesus is alive and He wants to be their friend forever.

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### Jesus and Peter | Activity 1

Find time today or later this week to complete these activities together!

#### What you need:

"Jesus and Peter" Activity Page, "Jesus and Peter" B&W Cardstock or Paper Scissors
Clear Tape
Craft Sticks

#### What to do:

- 1. Prepare before: Print the "Jesus and Peter" Activity Page on cardstock or paper.
- 2. Cut out Jesus and Peter and help your little ones tape them to craft sticks.
- 3. Retell the story of Jesus and Peter -- of when Peter denies Jesus 3 times, Jesus forgives Peter, and Jesus wants to be Peter's friend forever!



### In the Heart | Activity 2

### What you need:

A Large Piece of Paper Markers / Crayons / Colored Pencils

#### What to do:

- 1. Before: Draw a large heart on the piece of paper.
- 2. Ask: Who does Jesus love? That's right! Jesus loves everyone!
- 3. Encourage your kids to draw people Jesus loves in the heart themselves, family, friends, etc.
- 4. Remind them that Jesus loves everyone and wants to be their friend forever!
